

Public Invited To Presentation On Turbine

A public presentation of plans to install a wind turbine in the Falmouth Technology Park will be made at 6 PM on Thursday, November 1.

The meeting will be held at 82 Technology Park Drive, in the Falmouth Technology Park. The project, initiated in 2004 by Webb Research Corporation, was recently transferred to Notus Clean Energy, LLC.

Plans call for installation of a single wind turbine at 100 Technology Park Drive, which is at the southern terminus of the street. The proposed location has no residential abutters and is adjacent to town land, a sand quarry and the Technology Park. The turbine will have a rated capacity of approximately 1.5mW (1.5 million Watts) and a hub height of 262 feet (80m). Electricity generated by the turbine will be used by Webb Research Corporation, with excess generation transferred into the utility grid.
